Those who must leave for family or religious reasons on Saturday evening will be expected to stay until the end of the Ordeal which could last until 7 PM.

- LATE FEE** (per person) \$10.00 - For everyone registering after the noon deadline on Friday before the ordeal.

Candidates should bring uniform (But do not wear it when you arrive), medications with written instructions, work clothes, work gloves, sleeping bag, ground cloth, sun protection, jacket, work shoes, poncho, flashlight, pocket knife and a good attitude. Tents, food and eating utensils will be supplied. Remember the scout Motto! Bring warm clothing for the evenings, especially in December.
2. Candidates should leave radios, games, candy, soda, fireworks and other snacks and dangerous objects at home.
3. Candidates should arrive at the campout at 7 PM on the Friday and should plan on leaving Sunday by noon (with the exception of the December ordeal, plan on leaving by 7 PM on Saturday). Remember to eat supper before you arrive on Friday evening.
4. Candidates are expected to stay for the entire three days of the Ordeal (with the exception of the December ordeal that only lasts two days.).
